Andrew McAfee is the Music Director/Conductor of the Triangle Youth Ballet since 2008.

He played Principal Horn with the North Carolina Symphony for 15 years (1992-2007) and taught horn at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC) from 2005-2016 and currently is Principal Horn of the Chamber Orchestra of the Triangle and NC Opera orchestra.

Mr. McAfee completed his Bachelor of Music in Performance at Northwestern University and has won national auditions for positions with the Fresno Philharmonic, Honolulu

Symphony, Columbus Symphony, New Mexico Symphony and the North Carolina Symphony Orchestras.

He studied conducting for 9 summers with Maestro Harold Farberman at the Conductor's Institute and then with Maestro Ransom Wilson at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts where he completed his Master of Music in Orchestral Conducting.

As Music Director/Conductor of the Triangle Youth Ballet in Chapel Hill, Mr. McAfee has conducted full orchestral productions of Tchaikovsky's *Sleeping Beauty* in May 2008 and March 2009, *The Nutcracker* every year since December 2008, and Prokofiev's *Peter and the Wolf* in April 2012.
